Text: Mark 7:24-30
*(Story of the Syro-phoenician
woman)*

1.) What happened when the Syro-phoenician woman spoke with a voice of faith?

“Saying”

- “an emphatic word, a declaration, a sentiment uttered” (*greek meaning of “saying”*)
- Syro-phoenician woman expressed her deep-rooted sentiments by the words she spoke
- She declared what she believed in her heart
- Words expressing what you believe in your heart will produce something in your life

Mark 7:29 in other translations:

- “Because of this word go;...” (Young Literal Transl.)
- “For such a reply,...” (NIV)
- “Because of your answer,...” (New Century Version)

- “If you can answer like that,...” (Phillips Version)
- “...since you have said that” (Moffatt Transl.)
- Mark 7:29
- “If you can say that...” (Goodspeed)
- “Because you said this,...” (Beck Transl.)
- “Because of your response to me...” (Johnson Paraphrase)
- “For saying that,...” (New English Bible)
- “In reward for this word of thine...” (Knox Transl.)

2.) What happens when you speak with a “Voice of Faith”?
